TOC's membership elected Ron Ellis and Nick Alexander and re-elected incumbents Billy Morey, George Todaro, Michael Wellman and Jack Owens to its Board of Directors in June. Ellis, Alexander, Morey, Todaro and Wellman were elected to three-year terms, and Owens was elected to a one-year term. The new Board officially took office on July 1st and attended its first board meeting of the fiscal year on July 19 in Del Mar.

Ellis has been training since 1980 and has also served as a racing commentator for Fox TV Network and TVG. Among his many stakes winners are Twice the Vice, Exotic Wood, Pirates Revenge, Include Me Out, Benchmark, Rail Trip, Declans Moon, Don't Get Mad and Buzzards Bay.

Alexander, a native of Southern California, is the owner of Nick Alexander Imports. He has raced Thoroughbreds for 35 years, including graded stakes winner Grazen. He also runs a horse ranch in Santa Ynez.

Morey first joined the board in November 2012 to fill a vacancy created by the resignation of Ron McAnally. He is an owner, breeder and trainer and a native of Redwood City, California. He currently maintains a barn of 30-40 horses predominantly in Northern California.

Todaro has served on the board since March 2012. A resident of Seattle, WA, he is a nationally renowned medical researcher and founder of several biotech companies. He has been an owner and breeder since 1991, currently has about 70 horses in training and has campaigned many stakes winners.

Wellman, a native Californian, is president of International Molders, Inc., a manufacturing and international distribution company. He started in the claiming game 37 years ago and has since experienced all aspects of owning and breeding. He was first elected to the TOC board in 2012.

Owens was re-elected to the board in 2012 having previously served several terms beginning with the initial TOC election. He also served as Chairman of the Board in 2001-03, 2004-05 and 2011. A graduate of Stanford, he has been a lawyer for more than 30 years. Owens has been an owner and breeder for 30 years, racing predominantly in northern California.

A total of 7,471 ballots were mailed out to eligible voters, and 1,497 qualifying ballots were received. The complete vote tally is available for viewing on TOC's web site at www.toconline.com.



Senator Rod Wright's legislation on sports wagering was held in the Senate Appropriations Committee following the Department of Justice's estimation of the approximate \$8 million enforcement costs.

Negotiations on Internet Poker are in high gear behind the scenes in the Capitol. Although it seems unlikely that a deal will come together in the final weeks of session, that is often exactly when the "big deals" are put together. TOC has invested a great deal of time and effort educating legislators about the importance of Thoroughbred racing, maintaining a high profile in the Capitol and building better relationships with influential Native American tribes interested in passage of an Internet Poker bill.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The Assembly returned from its summer recess on the 5th of August and the Senate returns on August 12th. Both houses will adjourn for the year on Septem-
